
VISEGRAD GRANTS

- DEADLINES: February 1, June 1, October 1 (midday)
- FOCUS: V4 region and/or promotion abroad
- FORMAT: min. 3 x V4 (e.g., CZ + partners from HU, SK, PL)
- TARGET: legal entities (CSOs, public institutions, municipalities...)
- DURATION: 18 months
- BUDGETS: ≈ €20,000 (> €10,000 audited)
- THEMES: culture and heritage, education & capacity-building,
innovation & RDI, regional development, environment, tourism,
democratic values and the media, public policy,
social development

VISEGRAD+ GRANTS

- DEADLINES: February 1, June 1, October 1 (midday)
- FOCUS: V4 region + Eastern Partnership + Western Balkans
- FORMAT: min. 3 x V4 + partners from EaP and/or WB6
- TARGET: legal entities (CSOs, public institutions, municipalities...)
- DURATION: 18 months
- BUDGETS: ≈ €20,000 (> €10,000 audited)
- THEMES: culture and heritage, education & capacity-building,
innovation & RDI, regional development, environment, tourism,
democratic values and the media, public policy,
social development + specific regional objectives

EXPECTATIONS

- Original project idea + regional added value
- Active involvement of project partners
- Goal-oriented approach (projects with impact)

BASIC GRANT CONDITIONS

- Grant covers up to 100% of project budget
- Grant paid in 2 (or 3) tranches (ca. 80% advance-payment, the rest after reporting)
- Up to 15% of grant can be used for overhead costs (project management costs, tangible/intangible assets, etc.)
- All other costs eligible (accommodation/board, travel, honoraria, promotion...)
- One project per applicant/grantee (partnerships not limited)



HOW TO PROCEED?

1—PREPARE

- Get inspired by previous projects;
see [Inspirational Projects](#)
- Find partners
- Consult the fund
- If rejected, request feedback



HOW TO PROCEED?

2—APPLY

- Register at <https://my.visegradfund.org/>
- Fill out the form and submit
- Await the results (ca. 60 days)



HOW TO PROCEED?

3—RUN

- Fulfill formal criteria (project webpage, bank account)
- Conclude grant contract
- Implement the project



HOW TO PROCEED?

4—REPORT

- Fill out and submit Final Report
(incl. Financial/Audit reports)
- Settle leftover/receive final tranche

V4 GEN MINI-GRANTS

- DEADLINES: March 15, July 15, November 15 (midday)
- FOCUS: V4 region + immediate neighborhood
- FORMAT: min. 2 x V4 + partners from Austria, Germany and/or Ukraine
- TARGET: entities working with youth (schools, CSOs...)
- DURATION: 6 months
- BUDGETS: < €10,000 (€50–60 lump sum per person/day)
- THEMES: sustainability and resilience, heritage and remembrance,
health & active lifestyle, democratic values & civic virtues,
arts & culture, practical competences & entrepreneurship

VISEGRAD SCHOLARSHIPS

DEADLINES: April 15 (midday)

FOCUS: V4 region + immediate neighborhood

FORMAT: internal (V4), incoming (→ V4), outgoing (→ EaP, WB6)

TARGET: scholars (MA/post-MA) + accredited private/public HEIs

DURATION: 1–2 semesters

BUDGETS: €3,000/sem. (scholar) + €1,500 sem. (host)

VISEGRAD FELLOWSHIPS

- DEADLINES: rolling basis (Jan.–June, August–November)
 - FOCUS: V4 region
 - FORMAT: individual research, guest lecturing
 - TARGET: doctoral students, postdoc researchers/lecturers
 - DURATION: 2–10 weeks
 - BUDGETS: €500/week (paid in two tranches—80% + 20%)
